myPhone 1045/1082 is designed for use in GSM 900/1800 MHz.

Large keys with clear lettering, contrast, colour display, flashlight and Bluetooth mark your myPhone 1045/1082.

#### **SAFETY**



# Turning the phone on and off


\* Attention: Do not switch the phone in places where using mobile phones is forbidden or when it may cause interference or danger.

To turn on the phone press and hold the <red handset> key.

If the phone asks you for a PIN code, enter the code (it will be displayed as: \*\*\*\*) and press the **<green handset>** key.


# SIM card, memory card and battery inserting

If the phone is turned on – switch it off. Take off the back cover – gently press and move the lid down to take it off.




Insert the SIM card – SIM card should be placed with its gold contacts facing down in a way that the recess is stamped.


Insert the memory card — to open the card reader lid gently slide it down. MicroSD memory card must be placed with its gold contacts facing down, in a way that its recess is stamped. Close the memory card lid gently sliding it upwards.



The battery should be inserted in such a way so that the gold connectors on the battery contact the gold contacts in battery recess in your mobile phone.



#### Put on the back cover.



# Charging the phone

Charging without using the charging base.

Connect the charger with your mobile

phone via a charging slot, Insert the charger plug into a wall socket.

\*Attention: Improper connection of the charger can cause serious damage to your phone. Damage caused by misuse is not covered by your warranty.

During or after charging an icon appears: (or similar). Unplug the charger from

the electrical outlet after charging.

Disconnect the charger cable from the charging slot in your mobile phone.

Charging with the use of charging base.

Connect one end of the charger with charging slot of the charging base, then

plug the charger into a wall outlet.

Insert the phone into your charging base.

\*Attention: Improper connection of the charger can cause serious damage to your phone. Damage caused by misuse is not covered by your warranty.

During or after charging an icon appears: (or similar). Unplug the charger from

the electrical outlet after charging.

Disconnect the charging base cable from wall socket.

# Low battery indicator information

When the battery is discharged, you will see a low battery indicator on display.

The battery icon is empty. If the battery level is too low, the phone automatically turns off. To use the phone, re-charge the battery.

# 2. Using the basic features

#### Menu access

To get the Menu access press the Navigation key **<up>** or **<down>**.

Using keys <up> and <down> select the appropriate option.

Press the **<green handset>** key, to confirm (enter the option) or the **<red handset>** key, to go back to the main screen (standby mode).

# Customize your phone

myPhone 1045/1082 can be customized to your own needs. It will make using it much easier.

#### Enable or disable the silent mode

To enable or disable the Silent Mode in standby Mode use the zero key <0>. Press and hold it for about 3 seconds until statement appears "silent mode activated".

# Sounds and user profiles

To set the phone volume level go to [**Profiles**] option in phone's Menu.

Press navigation key <up> or <down>, to enter phones Menu. Then, using keys <up> and <down>, select option

[Profiles] and press the <green handset> key.

Select the appropriate profile from the list, press the **<green handset>** key  $\rightarrow$  [Options]  $\rightarrow$  [Activate]  $\rightarrow$  **<green handset>** key to confirm your choice.

- $\rightarrow$  [Options]  $\rightarrow$  [Customize]  $\rightarrow$  the <green handset>, to edit profile according to your own needs.
  - [Alert type] press the <green handset> → [Options] → [Change]
     → select the appropriate alert type.
  - [Ring type] press the <green handset> → [Options] → [Change]
     → select the appropriate ring type.
  - [Ringtone] you can change the ringtone for incoming calls – press the <green handset> → [Options]

- $\rightarrow$  [Change]  $\rightarrow$  [Select], select the ringtone <green handset>  $\rightarrow$  [OK].
- [Message] you can set an alert for incoming message press the <green handset> → [Options] → [Change] → select sound and confirm by pressing the <green handset> key → [OK].
- [Message volume] enables you to set the volume of incoming message press the <green handset> key→ [Options] → [Change] and press the volume control keys <+> and <-> (on the left side of your phone), to set the volume level.

- [Keypad Tone] press the <green handset> key → [Options] → [Change] and select the type of keypad tone. Confirm by pressing <green handset> key → [OK].
- [Key tone volume] you can easily adjust the key tone volume level press the <green handset> key → [Options] → [Change] and press the volume control keys <+> and <-> (on the left side of your phone), to set the volume level.
- [System alert] press the <green handset> key → [Options] → [Change] and turn the system alert on or off. Confirm by pressing the <green handset> key → [OK].

SOS key settings

myPhone 1045/1082 is equipped with SOS key. It is located on the back of the phone, over the battery cover:



To enable the SOS key, select in main [Menu] (navigation keys <up> or <down>)  $\rightarrow$  [SOS Setting]. A submenu appears with SOS key settings:

- [SOS number setting] it is possible to enter 5 numbers the phone will try to connect with after longer pressing the SOS key.
- To enter a number press the <green handset> key → [Options] → [Edit]

and enter the phone number.

After entering the last number, select:  $[Options] \rightarrow [Done]$ . To confirm all of the numbers select:  $[Options] \rightarrow [Save] \rightarrow [Done]$ . If there is no number saved in option [SOS number setting] long pressing of the SOS key activates the alarm sound for 5 seconds.

• [Love number setting] - It is an option allowing you to assign speed dial numbers to keys: <\*> and <#>.
The numbers can be assigned to different tabs "Male" and "Female". To enter the number press the <green handset> key → [Options] → [Edit] and enter the phone number. After entering the number, select: [Options] → [Done].

When you finish entering all Love numbers: [Options]  $\rightarrow$  [Save]  $\rightarrow$ 

# [Done].

- [SOS SMS content] a SMS that will be sent to numbers entered in [SOS number]. It is possible to enter your own text and save changes ([Options] → [Edit] → enter the SOS message content → [Options] → [Done]).
- [Select the object of SMS] The last option in SOS submenu is selecting phone numbers the alarm SMS will be sent to. It is possible to select all five receivers (all five entered SOS numbers) or, for example, only one of them.
- [Call waiting time] time after which the alarm sound stops, and the phone will attempt to call all sequential numbers set in the [SOS number setting].

#### Phone lock

Use the key [located on the right side of

your phone) to lock or unlock the phone.

Move the slider up to lock the phone or move it down to unlock it.

# Connectivity options

Making a phone call

In standby mode enter a phone number using alphanumeric keypad. It is recommended to enter the code number and then the phone number.

Press the <red handset> key, to terminate the phone call.

# Answering the phone

When there is an incoming call, press the  $\langle green\ handset \rangle$  key  $\rightarrow$  [Answer] in order to answer the phone.

Press the <red handset> key, to reject/ terminate a phone call.

# Text messages

Sending SMS message

Select: [Menu]  $\rightarrow$  [Messaging]  $\rightarrow$  [Write message].

Enter the text using the alphanumeric keypad. The characters are entered letter by letter as the phone is not equipped

with a dictionary.

The key <#> is used to select between different writing modes. There are the following modes available:

- ABC only upper case letters
- abc only lower case letters
- 123 only digits.

In order to enter a special character, for example: a dot, a comma or a hyphen etc., press the key <\*> and select a symbol from the list or press the key <1> as many times as needed.

To make a space between two words press the key <0>.

An example of entering characters:

To enter letter "b", press the "2" key

twice. To enter letter "d", press the "3" key once, etc.

After entering the text of a message, press the **<green handset>** key  $\rightarrow$  [Options]  $\rightarrow$  [Send to].

A list of options appears:

- [Enter number] enter number by using the numeric keypad <green handset> key → [Send],
- [Add from Phonebook] when you select this option, simply enter the first few letters of the contact name to search for it in the phone book. Select [OK], to confirm your choice.
   After entering the number / selecting a contact from phone book, select: [Options] → [Send], to send a message.

# Message displaying

Select: [Menu]  $\rightarrow$  [Messaging]  $\rightarrow$  [Inbox], select a message from the list and press the **<green handset>** key  $\rightarrow$  [View], to read the message.

# Phonebook in myPhone 1045/1082

#### Add new contact

To add new contact select: [Menu] → [Phonebook] → <UP>key→ [Add a new contact]→<OK> key

Select a place for saving a contact (SIM or Phone). Then insert a contacts name [Options] → [Edit]) and phone number.

Press the **<green handset>** key  $\rightarrow$  **[Options]**  $\rightarrow$  **[Save]** to save a contact.

To move contacts between SIM card and Phone memory select: [Menu]  $\rightarrow$  [Phonebook]  $\rightarrow$  [OK]  $\rightarrow$  [Add new contact]  $\rightarrow$  [Phonebook settings] [Move contacts].

Search for contact

To search for contact, select: [Menu] → [Phonebook].

Enter first letter of contact's name.

Contacts that start with this letter appear on the list. To search through these contacts simply use the navigation keys <up>and <down>.

After finding the desired contact and pressing the **<green handset>** key → **[Options]** it is possible to:

- [view] see contacts details (name and number).
- [Send text message] send SMS.
- [Edit] edit contacts details.
- [Delete] delete contact.
- [Copy] copy contact from SIM card to Phone and conversely.
- [Phone book settings] enter additional options such as speed dial, memory status etc.

#### Delete contacts

To delete all contacts, select: [Menu] → [Phonebook] → [Add new contact] → [Options] → [Phonebook settings] → [Delete all contacts]

To delete single contact, select: [Menu]  $\rightarrow$  [Phonebook]  $\rightarrow$  search for contact you want to delete **<green handset>**  $\rightarrow$  [Options]  $\rightarrow$  [Delete].

## 3. Using advanced features

#### Call a contact from Phonebook

To establish connection with contact saved in [Phonebook] submenu perform the following steps:

In standby mode press the navigation key <up>.

Enter [Phonebook] submenu, and confirm [OK] by pressing <green handset> key.

Search for contact on the list (by entering the name and contacts number), and establish a phone call by pressing

## <green handset> key and select [Call].

#### Missed calls

All missed calls are shown on phone's display.

A message about a missed call and an icon: \_ , appears on display.

To check who called or to make a connection with missed number, do as follows:

Press [View] (with the <green handset> key).

The other way is a [Call centre]. Select [Menu]  $\rightarrow$  [Call centre]  $\rightarrow$  [Call history]  $\rightarrow$  [Missed calls].

To call a missed number press the  $\langle green\ handset \rangle \ key \rightarrow [Call].$ 

## Loudspeaker

During an active phone call press [Options] and select [H-Free/H-Held] from the list to activate Loudspeaker mode.

## Speed dial

Select option [Phonebook]  $\rightarrow$  [Add new contact]  $\rightarrow$  [Phonebook settings]  $\rightarrow$  [Speed dial].

The following list appears: [Status] and [Set number]. Using the green handset key set the [Status] to: On.

Select option [**Set number**]. On the left side of display there are numbers that correspond with keypad. With the use of option: [**Options**]  $\rightarrow$  [**Edit**]  $\rightarrow$  **select from Phonebook** it is possible to assign a contact to a certain key [**Speed dial key**]. After setting numbers select [**Back**], to go back to phone's Menu.

To establish a connection press and hold (for about 3 seconds) the key on numeric keypad with assigned number.

#### International calls

In standby mode press the key <\*> twice until a sign "+" appears.

Enter a full number (country code, city code and contact number) and press the <green handset> key, to make a phone

call.

#### 4. Other features

## Date and time setting

To set date and time select the following option:

[Menu]  $\rightarrow$  [Settings]  $\rightarrow$  [Phone settings]  $\rightarrow$  [Time and date].

Select [Set time/date], confirm [OK] by pressing <green handset>.

Enter current date and confirm it **[OK]** by pressing **<green handset>** key.

Using the navigation key <a href="#"><down></a>, enter current date. Confirm by pressing <a href="#">green handset></a> key.

In [Set format] option select the type of date and time you want to perform on

display.

## Language settings

To set or change the language select the following option: [Menu]  $\rightarrow$  [Settings]  $\rightarrow$  [Phone settings]  $\rightarrow$  [Language].

Select language from the list.

## Display settings

[Menu]  $\rightarrow$  [Settings]  $\rightarrow$  [Phone settings]  $\rightarrow$  [Display]:

[Wallpaper] → select [System] (if you want to define system wallpaper) or [User defined] (if you want to add your own wallpaper), then select one of wallpapers available on the list. To

preview chosen wallpaper select [View]. To set the wallpaper select: [OK].

- [Power on display] → select [System] (if you want to browse system images) or [User defined] (if you want to add you own animation), select animation from the list. To preview your choice, select [View]. To set the animation press: [View] → [OK].
- [Power off display] proceed similarly to the above-described power on display.
- [Show date and time] disable / enable the date and time located on the main screen.

## Call settings

Call settings are available in [Menu]  $\rightarrow$  [Call centre]  $\rightarrow$  [Call settings]. The following settings are available: Blacklist, Auto redial, Call time reminder, Reject by SMS and Answer mode.

## Alarm configuration

In main [Menu] select [Organizer].

Go to option [Alarm] by pressing [OK].

Select any item from the list and press [Edit].

Enter [Status] to enable or disable alarm.

Press navigation key **<down>**. It is possible to set the time of the alarm using

the numeric keypad.

After pressing **<down>** key again you may choose when you want the alarm to go off (once, every day, custom, etc.). It also possible to set the alarm tone and alert type.

To confirm settings, select: [Save] → [OK]).

#### Calculator

In [Menu] mode select: [Organizer].

Select [Calculator] from the list using the **<green handset>** key.

Basic arithmetic operations can be performed using the alphanumeric keyboard (typing numbers, digits).

Actions operator can be set by using navigation key (**<up>**, **<down>**).

Press the **<green handset>** key to see the result.

## Factory settings

To restore factory settings, select in Menu mode: [Settings]  $\rightarrow$  [Restore settings].

Restoring code is: 1122

## Flashlight

To activate the flashlight, slide up side zipper ... Slide it down to deactivate it.

## Call history

There is an option [Call history] in your phone. You can find it in [Menu]  $\rightarrow$  [Call centre]  $\rightarrow$  [Call history]. It is possible to browse your calls register – missed calls, dialled calls, received calls etc. There are the following options available in submenu:

- Missed calls
- Dialled calls
- Received calls
- All calls
- Delete call logs

#### **Tasks**

There is a Tasks option available in your phone. It is possible to add your own note and save it in phones memory.

To add a new task, select: [Menu] → [Organizer] → [Tasks] → [Add].

You can enter text, select: **<Subject>**, press key No.5 and enter the text you want to remember. Note length is a maximum 35 characters. You can also set the date and time (**[Due time]**).

Another option is **[Alarm]**. You may enable or disable it.

To save the task, select with the **<green** handset> key: [Options] → [Save].

The alarm will start at the certain date and time and remind us about the task.

## Audio player

In [Multimedia] option there is an Audio player. It makes it possible to play MP3 files saved on the memory card. Audio files should be saved on microSD memory card in My Music folder — they will automatically be added to a playlist in audio player.

You can operate the player using the following buttons:

Button	Function	
+	Volume up	
-	Volume down	
<4>	Previous	
<5>	Play/ pause	



When you turn on the audio player, there are the following options available in the lower left corner of the display:

- Playlist list of all recordings
- Settings audio player settings available in: [List] → [Options] → [Settings]:
  - Playlist auto generating set to "Enable"
  - Repeat repeat recordings
  - Shuffle enable or disable random playing
  - Background playing play in background.

## FM radio in myPhone 1045/1082

Activating FM radio requires plugging in the earphones. It really improves the quality of listening to a radio broadcast. Headphones plugged in act as an external antenna.

In Menu mode select option:  $[Multimedia] \rightarrow [Radio FM]$ , or simply slide up the side FM slider.

Select: [Options]  $\rightarrow$  [Auto search]  $\rightarrow$  [Select] to search for available radio stations.

All available channels will be saved in [Channel list] folder.

Radio volume control is done by using the <+> and <-> keys located on the left

side of the phone cover.

Radio control is made by using the following keys:

Key	Function
<down></down>	Changing the frequency of 0.1 MHz down.
<up></up>	Changing the frequency of 0.1 MHz up.
Side	Enable the radio (slide the slider up)
slider – FM	Disable the radio (slide the slider down)

To turn off the radio, move the side FM slider down.

#### Calendar

There is a calendar available in myPhone 1045/1082. You can view the current date or check different dates and days.

To enter the calendar, select: [Menu] → [Organizer] → [Calendar].

#### **Bluetooth**

In myPhone 1045/1082 Bluetooth module is available. It is used to connect wirelessly with devices equipped with Bluetooth function.

To enter Bluetooth module, select:

[Menu]  $\rightarrow$  [Settings]  $\rightarrow$  [Connectivity]  $\rightarrow$  [Bluetooth]. The following options available:

- [Power] The <green handset> key enables or disables Bluetooth radio broadcasting. A blue icon with letter "B" on the main screen indicates that Bluetooth module is on.
- [Visibility] enabling this feature allows other devices with Bluetooth technology to see us on the list of available devices.
- [My device] you can find [Search new device] option here. It allows us to display a list of available Bluetooth devices within range. It is possible to connect to devices available on the list.

• [My name] – allows you to enter the name under which the device will appear when you connect to other Bluetooth devices. The default name is myPhone 1045/1082.

## Pairing Bluetooth devices.

To connect with other Bluetooth device, select it from the list of available devices ([Menu] → [Settings] → [Connectivity] → [Bluetooth] → [My device] → [Search new device]) select device you want to connect with and press [Pair]. Statement asking if Passcode matched? appears on both devices. Press [Yes]. Devices are connected.

## Sending files via Bluetooth.

To send file to device that we are connected with (paired), enter: [Menu] → [File manager] → [Options] → [Open] select from memory card file you want to send, mark it and select [Options] → [Send] → [via Bluetooth]. When receiver accepts the file – it will be sent.

## **Troubleshooting**

Alert	Sample solution	
Insert SIM card	Make sure that your SIM card has been properly installed.	
Enter your PIN	If your SIM card is secured by a PIN code, enter a PIN after turning on the phone and confirm it by pressing < <b>OK</b> > key.	
Network	In areas where there is a	

error	weak signal or reception, making and receiving calls may be impossible. Move to another location and try again.

It is impossible to establish a connection

 If the number was correctly entered, make sure that the green handset key has been pressed;

Nobody can get through to myPhone 1045/1082.

The phone must be switched off;

You cannot hear the caller / caller cannot hear myPhone 1045/1082 holder.

- Microphone should be placed very close to your mouth;
- If you use the headset check if it has been properly connected;
- Check if the build in microphone has not been covered;

## Poor sound quality during a phone call

 Make sure if the speaker and the microphone have not been covered;

It is impossible to make a phone call

- Check if number entered with the use of numeric keypad is correct;
- Check if number saved in [Phone book] is correct;

 If it is necessary, enter the correct number.

How to check the software version?

There are two codes to check the software version. The type of code depends on the version of the phone.

The codes are as follows:

- . \*#868602# and select option
  [Version]
- . \*#8008#

#### 5. Care and maintenance

Comments on the proper use of battery

The battery in this phone may be powered via a charger. If the battery level is low, charge it. To extend battery life, let it be up to land before connecting to the charger.

If you are not using a charger, disconnect it from the phone. Overcharging will shorten battery life. Battery temperature affects the quality of its load.
